UPDATE: September 2, 2014

In 2012, contrary our conclusions, the legal system ruled that 91%, of the extrajudicial killings were "justified". Only 10 officers were ever charged with a crime. Of the 25 killings by security guards and vigilantes, 16 were charged including Zimmerman. To date, only 2 police officers have been convicted of manslaughter and are serving minimum 4-year sentences. Two officers pleaded guilty to vehicular manslaughter in exchange for 6-month sentences. Those marked in green were found "not guilty", and red "guilty".*
